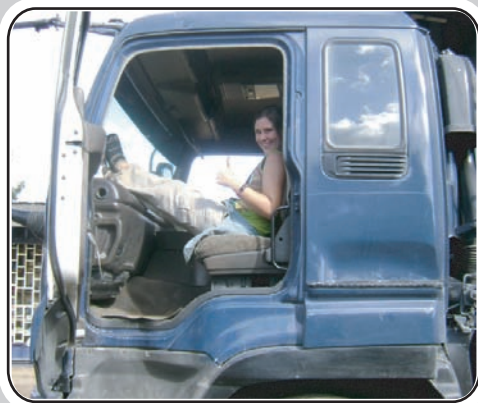


MAJI MOTO :: NEWSLETTER :: 14th OCTOBER 2008



Life is never perfect - our site has been robbed by our own fundies.. But as we finally have timber - the school building is raising fast. We are doing now the formwork for slob concreting - all the polls standing high create the incredible view of the dense forrest right in the middle of our site.

Also latrines are nearly finished - the Polish-Kenyan team is doing really great!
